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### Flexible reporting

Clients First found that the initial Sage Intelligence module has evolved significantly since prior generations with performance being the key focus in the development of the new Report Designer Add-In. Sage Intelligence significantly enhances the reporting and delivery capabilities through adoption of “current technologies,” the latest being the use of In-Memory technology in the new Report Designer Add-In, to help clients to quickly create customized financial reports from the ground up in the familiar environment of Microsoft Excel. The newer General Ledger (GL) formulas are easy and utilize the fast In-Memory engine rather than Excel’s regular formula processing engine. The Report Designer Add-In also allows users to specify the level of detail they require and then drill down if more detail is needed, greatly enhancing flexibility in reporting.
